

PROBATE COURT OF MONROE COUNTY, OHIO

COURT COSTS/DEPOSITS

MARRIAGE LICENSE:

\$45.00

The bride and groom must have a photo ID (i.e. Driver's License, State ID), Birth Certificate and Social Security Card. If previously divorced, a certified copy of most recent divorce decree or death certificate. Each of the persons seeking a license shall personally appear in the probate court within the county where either resides, or, if neither is a resident of this state, where the marriage is expected to be solemnized. If neither party is a resident of Ohio, the marriage may be solemnized only in the county where the license is obtained. The couple must be married within 60 days; license expires 60 days after issuance. It is the responsibility of the applying couple to determine that the marriage officiant is licensed in the state of Ohio. If either applicant is under the age of eighteen years, the judge shall require the applicants to state that they received marriage counseling satisfactory to the court. A Statement of Marriage Counseling must be completed by an ordained minister or counselor. A Statement of Marriage Counseling form is available in the Probate Court Office, Room 39, Monroe County Courthouse, Woodsfield, Ohio.
